Fluorescent Tubes and CFL Bulbs

Unbroken fluorescent tubes and CFL bulbs are accepted. Inquire at Pay Station or ask a volunteer where to deposit these items.

Beach/Roadside Litter

Beach and roadside litter is accepted at no charge.

Noxious Weeds

Noxious weeds (Class A, B, and C) are invasive, non-native plants. As listed in our separate brochure, noxious weeds are accepted at our facility currently at no charge to the general public. Brochures are available at the Pay Station which outline how various noxious weeds can be dealt with which minimize the amount of plant mass which is brought to the facility for final disposal.

Annual Hazardous Waste Collection

Up to 25 gallons of household hazardous waste. Annual collection date is normally in the Spring. Watch for announcement at our front gate.

We offer the following services with the goal of achieving Zero Waste

Self-Separated Recycling

Free disposal of a growing list of paper, plastic, metal, and glass materials brought clean and separated to our Recycle Plaza. Also includes motor oil, antifreeze and rechargeable batteries.

E-CYCLE

Free recycling of televisions, computers, monitors, laptops and tablets, e-readers, portable DVD players, keyboards, mice, cables, and most other electronic devices.

\$4 Fee for Printers, scanners, copiers.

Take It or Leave It (TIOLI)

A free exchange of goods for the entire Lopez Community.

Garbage Disposal

Volume based garbage disposal including mattresses, upholstered furniture, tires and large appliances.

Self Separated Recycling

Listed by receiving container (Bin).
(Clean items without residue only!)

Paper Products

Mixed Paper

Paper and newsprint, books and envelopes, thin non-corrugated cardboard, egg cartons, paper bags

Corrugated Cardboard

Corrugated "wavy center" cardboard. No need to flatten or remove tape and staples. No waxed, dirty, stained cardboard.

Shredded Paper

Put all shredded paper into a paper bag and tape or staple securely closed. Unsecured shredded paper creates a huge mess that is difficult to clean up.

Plastics (Remove lids & tops and place in lid bin)

NO containers for motor oil, brake fluid, antifreeze, hazardous waste (anything with toxic warnings).

Clear & Lightly Tinted (NOT DARK) Bottles
Example: Soda & Water Bottles



HDPE

Cloudy Bottles & Jugs
Example: Cloudy Milk & Gallon Water Jugs



HDPE

Solid White & Color Bottles & Jugs
Example: Solid White Milk & Colored Detergent Jugs

A limited amount of black agricultural plastic planting pots and trays are accepted at the TIOLI and the Recycling Plaza and are available for reuse.

Due to current market conditions LSWDD is currently NOT accepting the following plastics for recycling:

#3 through #7 bottles, tubs and clamshells
Plastic Bags/Film, Visqueen, bubble wrap

Glass Bottles and Jars

Bottles and jars

Only bottles and jars. All colors. Labels and neck wrappings are acceptable. Put caps, corks and lids in container provided. NO PYREX, WINDOWS, MIRRORS, PLATE GLASS, LIGHT BULBS, CERAMICS, DRINKING GLASSES.

Metals (Rinsed Food and Beverage)

Clean Aluminum Cans and Lids

Most soft drink and cat food cans. Please check with our magnet if unsure (Aluminum does not stick to a magnet).

Clean Steel Cans and Lids

Most canned food, coffee. Please check with our magnet if unsure. (Steel will stick to a magnet) NO AEROSOL OR PRESSURIZED STEEL CONTAINERS.

Aluminum foil, trays, and pans

Flatten the foil, and only clean items please. NO COLORED FOIL

Metals (Non-Food and Beverage)

Ferrous

Pure Scrap Steel and Iron.

Non-ferrous Scrap Metal

Aluminum, Brass, Copper, Bronze, Stainless Steel

Wire

Insulated or bare copper or aluminum electrical wire

Mixed Steel (Small household appliances)

Ferrous Metal (50% or more steel or iron). Small items with limited rust accepted at no charge.

Automotive Fluids

Oil and other petroleum based products

Motor Oil, Hydraulic Fluid, Kerosene, Transmission Fluid, And Diesel Fuel. (5-gallon limit per day.) ABSOLUTELY NO GASOLINE OR WATER CONTAMINATED FLUIDS

Antifreeze

Used or New Antifreeze. (5-gallon limit per day.)

Batteries

Batteries

All rechargeable batteries including lead acid car batteries, portable power tool batteries, cell phone, and portable device batteries.

Take it or Leave it Accepted Items

Partial list below

All items must be accepted by a Volunteer

Clothing (Clean and Dry)

Un-torn men's, women's, and children's clothing. outer garments including coats, robes, hats, belts, scarves, shoes, and socks in pairs. also small child, baby clothes, bras, ties, swimsuits, and gloves.

Bedding & Linens (Clean and Dry)

Bath towels, wash cloths, hand towels, fitted sheets, top sheets, blankets, comforters, mattress pads, bedspreads, bed skirts, pillow cases, new throw/personal pillows. NO BED PILLOWS OR FOAM MATTRESS PADS

Books

Hard and soft cover books NO MAGAZINES

Recreational Items

Sporting goods, art work, frames, puzzles, teen and children's items, toys, games and more. NO VCR/CASSETTE TAPES.

E-Cycle Items (Working)

CD & DVD players, keyboards, routers, modems, stereos, peripherals, receivers, mixers, amplifiers, telephones, radios, keyboards, mice, cables, and most other electronic devices.

Electrical Appliances

All working small kitchen and household appliances, power tools and other small appliances.

Tools And Fasteners

All functional tools and fasteners.

Household Fixtures

All functional finished items such as doors, windows, racks and shelving.

Eye Glasses

All prescription glasses, non-prescription sun/reading glasses.

Agricultural Plastic

Clean pots, flats, trays, and flat drip line. Please remove all soil, rocks, and plant tags.

Fee Items

Mattresses, carpets, rugs, upholstered furniture (all acceptable with pay station receipt)

Sign-In Items (as space permits)

Windows, doors, exercise equipment, sinks, bathtubs, and all wood, plastic, and metal furniture.
